The Grover FFA would like to thank the community for their support at our 48th Annual Rocky Mountain Oyster Fry & Member Auction. Roughly 100 people ate at the dinner and around 75 people were at the auction with 43 registering to bid. Ten of the thirteen FFA members helped with the dinner and auction. Ten members and 13 items were sold in the live auction and 37 items were sold in the silent auction. Auction items were fewer than in previous years but the chapter emphasizes their effort in quality over quantity. There was a 4-way tie for highest bid on FFA members. Logan Cacciola, Josh Keiper, James Krist, and Mayson Cacciola sold for \$275 each! Gross profit for the live auction was \$4,345 and the gross profit for the silent auction was \$912 for a total gross profit of \$6,246.
