Parents of last year's freshmen who took the PSAT9 Test, sophomores who took the PSAT10 Test, and juniors who took the SAT Test will be receiving those results soon if they have not already arrived.

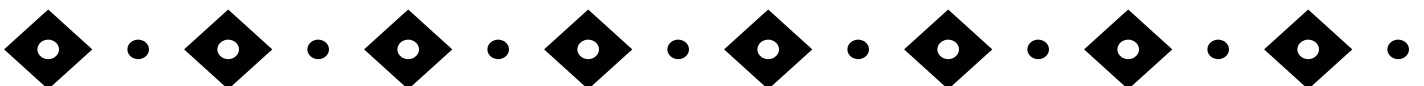

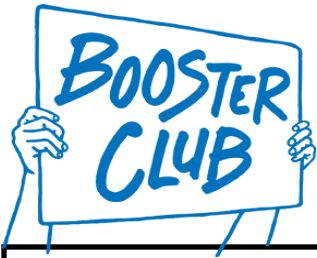
